Section 1. That section 1 of Ordinance No. 688, entitled "An ordinance relating to the use, conduct and operation of motor vehicles upon the public streets of Oregon City and prescribing penalties for violation of the provisions herein contained," passed July 12, 1914, and approved July 15, 1914, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. The rate of speed for motor vehicles upon the streets of Oregon City shall be at all times a reasonable speed to be governed by the conditions and circumstances up to and not exceeding eighteen miles per hour but a speed in excess of fifteen miles per hour upon any of the streets or highways of Oregon City shall be deemed an unreasonable speed and is hereby prohibited.

Section 1. The plans and specifications for the improvement of the street hereby referred to are approved by resolution adopted by the city council on the 27th day of July 1914, which said plans and specifications are referred to and made a part of this ordinance. The surface of the street shall be cut down or filled up the full width thereof and prepared and finished to the outside of road bed will be 4 feet above center and 12 inches above curb below the present established grade of the street and the sidewalk bed shall be completed by placing macadam thereon to a sufficient depth to bring the same to true grade according to the plans and specifications. Sidewalks and curbs shall be of concrete and crosswalks shall be placed as provided by specifications. Catch-basins shall be placed in order for proper drainage and the whole improvement shall be made and completed according to the plans and specifications which are hereby referred to and made a part of this ordinance.

Section 2. The improvement shall be classed as macadam and shall be maintained by Oregon City for the full period of ten years from the date of the acceptance thereof by the council.

Section 3. The city recorder is hereby authorized to advertise and receive proposals for said improvement but the city reserves the right to reject any and all bids therefor and the mayor and recorder shall enter in a contract or contracts with each person, firm or corporation to whom the contract or contracts are let by the city council of Oregon City for the improvement of parts thereof as specified in this ordinance.

Section 4. Each contract shall contain a stipulation to the effect that where the cost of the improvement under provisions of the contract shall exceed one-half the value of the property assessed for the improvement over the said one-half of the property assessed for the improvement that the said excess shall be paid out of the general fund of Oregon City and as to the balance each person, firm or corporation to whom the contract or contracts

are let shall look for payment only to the sum assessed upon the property liable to pay for said improvement and collected and paid into the city treasury of Oregon City for such purpose. The city shall not hold Oregon City liable for the cost or other expenses of the said work out of any other fund.

Section 5. Whereas, the condition of said street is and was dangerous to the health and safety of the public and its immediate improvement is necessary for the immediate preservation of the health and safety of the public in the portion of the city where an improvement exists; therefore, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its approval by the mayor.

This franchise shall be accepted within the period of thirty (30) days after its approval and made major by the said Oregon & California Railroad company, and as a condition of such acceptance shall remain in force for a period of ten (10) years, and shall be subject to the provisions of the charter of said city and the laws of the State of Oregon.

Oregon City Sewer Ordinance Follows:

Section 1. That the proposed improvement of Thirtieth Street, Oregon City, Oregon, from the west side of Center Street to the east side of Promenade Street shall be made according to the plans and specifications on file in the office of the city recorder and approved by a resolution adopted by the city council on the 12th day of August, 1914, which said plans and specifications are referred to and made a part of this ordinance. The surface of the street shall be cut down or raised up the full width thereof and re-prepared and finished that the sub-grade of the road bed will be nine inches at the center and twelve inches at the curb below the present established grade of the street and the said road-bed shall be completed by placing macadam thereon to sufficient depth to bring the same to true grade according to the plans and specifications. Side-walks shall be concrete except where upon application to the city council owners are permitted to have wooden walks laid. All of the walks shall be six feet wide and laid to the property line. Curbs shall be laid on each side of the macadamized portion of the street. Cross walks shall be four feet wide and not less than three inches thick. Catch basins shall be placed in order to provide proper drainage and the said improvement shall be made and completed by the contractor and shall be completed within the time specified in the contract and shall be subject to the approval of the city council. The contractor shall be responsible for the maintenance of the street during the progress of the work and shall be liable for any damages caused by the contractor. The contractor shall also be responsible for the removal of any material or debris from the street during the progress of the work.
