Shaw the right, privilege and franchise to run and operate public utility vehicle or vehicles upon and over the streets of Oregon City between Main and Seventh streets and Duane street, Mountain View, within Oregon City, and between Main and Seventh streets, Oregon City and Oswego, Oregon; and carry passengers and charge and collect fares therefor.

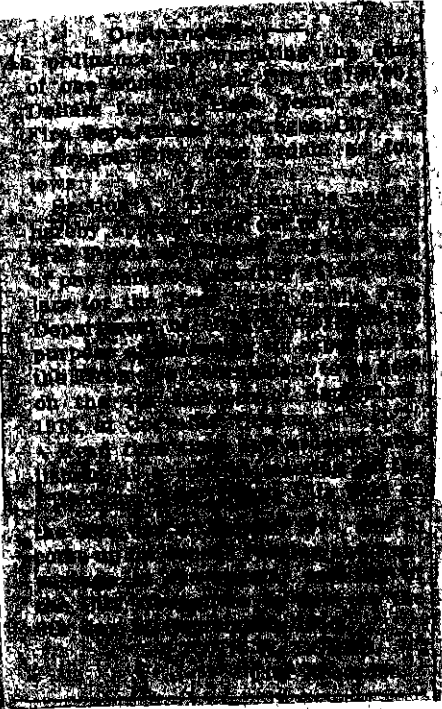
