

RESOLUTION NO. 16-08

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF OREGON CITY TO APPLY FOR A LOCAL GOVERNMENT GRANT FROM THE OREGON PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF GLEN OAK PARK AND AUTHORIZING THE COMMUNITY SERVICES DIRECTOR TO SIGN THE GRANT APPLICATION

WHEREAS, the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department is accepting applications for the Local Government Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oregon City desires to participate in this grant program to the greatest extent possible as a means of providing needed park and recreation acquisitions, improvements and enhancements; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission have identified park improvements at Glen Oak Park as a high priority need in the City of Oregon City; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of Oregon City have identified accessible parking and large open turf areas, a dog park, trails, a nature play area and landscape improvements as a high priority through the Park Master Plan process; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oregon City has available local matching funds to fulfill its share of obligation related to this grant application should the grant funds be awarded; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oregon City will provide adequate funding for on-going operations and maintenance of this park and recreation facility should the grant funds be awarded.

NOW, THEREFORE, OREGON CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The City Commission support the submittal of a grant application to the Oregon Park and Recreation Department for the development of Glen Oak Park and authorizes the Community Services Director to sign the grant application.


Section 2: This Resolution shall be effective following its adoption by the City Commission.
