SLOPE EASEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, THAT Alfred N. Hess and Dorothy Hess hereinafter called the GRANTOR, do(es) hereby grant unto the City of Oregon City, hereinafter called the CITY, its successors in interest and assigns, a permanent easement and right-of-way, including the permanent right to construct, reconstruct, and maintain <u>ROAD SLOPES</u> on the following described land:

A parcel of land lying in the Andrew Hood D.L.C. No. 44 in Section 9, Township 3 South, Range 2 East of the Willamette Meridian and being a portion of that property described in that deed to Alfred N. Hess & Dorothy Hess, and recorded in Book 488, Page 324, Film Records of Clackamas County, Oregon; the said parcel being that portion of said property included in a strip of land variable in width, lying northerly of and adjacent to the centerline of relocated Glen Oak Road, which centerline is described as follows:

Beginning at Engineer's Centerline Station 14+09.03 of Glen Oak Road, said Centerline Station being the South 1/4 corner of Section 9, Township 3 South, Range 2 East of the Willamette Meridian; thence South $88^{\circ}25'58''$ East 2660.91 feet to the southeast corner of said Section 9, Township 3 South, Range 2 East of the Willamette Meridian.

The widths in feet of the strip of land above referred to are as follows:

Station to	Station	Width on Northerly Side of Center Line
17+75	21+30	35
21+30	23+25	40

Bearings are based upon the Oregon Coordinate System, North Zone.

The parcel of land to which this description applies contains 8,826 square feet, more or less.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, the above described easement unto the CITY, its successors in interest and assigns forever.

GRANTOR reserves the right to use the surface of the land for walkways, plantings and related uses. Such uses undertaken by the GRANTOR shall not be inconsistent or interfere with the use of the subject easement area by the CITY. No building or utility shall be placed upon, under or within the property subject to the foregoing easement during the term thereof.

Upon completion of the construction, the CITY shall restore the surface of the property to a neat and orderly condition and shall indemnify and hold the GRANTOR harmless against any and all loss, cost or damage arising out of the exercise of the rights granted herein.

The true consideration of this conveyance is \$3,100.00, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by GRANTOR.

And the GRANTOR above named hereby covenants to and with the CITY, and CITY's successors in interest and assigns that GRANTOR is lawfully seized in fee simple of the above granted premises, free from all encumbrances (no exceptions) and that GRANTOR and their heirs and personal representatives shall warrant and forever defend the said premises and every part thereof to the CITY, its successors in interest and assigns against the lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming by, through, or under the GRANTOR.

In construing this easement and where the context so requires, the singular includes the plural and all grammatical changes shall be implied to make the provisions hereof apply equally to corporations and to individuals.
