Upon completion of the construction, the CITY shall restore the surface of the property to a neat and orderly condition and shall indemnify and hold the GRANTOR harmless against any and all loss, cost or damage arising out of the exercise of the rights granted herein.

The true consideration of this conveyance is \$1.00, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by GRANTOR, plus the value of any future Advance Finance Charges which might be caused to be placed against this property as a result of the Fir Street Storm Drainage project currently under way.
