ACCESS, POWER and WATERLINE EASEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, THAT <u>Neal F. & Myrle L. Lewis</u> hereinafter called the GRANTOR, do(es) hereby grant unto the City of Oregon City, hereinafter called the CITY, its successors in interest and assigns, a permanent easement and right-of-way, including the permanent right to construct, reconstruct, operate and maintain <u>an access road and a waterline and the neccessary power</u> <u>and telemetry wires</u> on the following described land:

See attached Exhibit "A" Legal Description and attached Exhibit "B" Sketch for Legal Description

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, the above described easement unto the CITY, its successors in interest and assigns forever.

GRANTOR reserves the right to use the surface of the said land not used for an access road, for walkways, plantings, parking and related uses. Such uses undertaken by the GRANTOR shall not be inconsistent or interfere with the use of the subject easement area by the CITY. No building or utility shall be placed upon, under or within the property subject to the foregoing easement during the term thereof, however, without the written permission of the CITY.

GRANTOR reserves the right to install and maintain a stock fence along the access road. Said fence is subject to removal by the CITY for the purpose of installing and maintaining waterlines. The CITY will install buried power and telemetry wiring for site usage.

Upon completion of the construction, the CITY shall restore the surface of the property not used for access purposes to its original condition and shall indemnify and hold the GRANTOR harmless against any and all loss, cost or damage arising out of the exercise of the rights granted herein.

The true consideration of this conveyance is as noted in Clackamas County Recorders Fee No. 82-34858.

And the GRANTOR above named hereby covenants to and with the CITY, and CITY's successors in interest and assigns that GRANTOR is lawfully seized in fee simple of the above granted premises, free from all encumbrances (no exceptions) and that GRANTOR and their heirs and personal representatives shall warrant and forever defend the said premises and every part thereof to the CITY, its successors in interest and assigns against the lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming by, through, or under the GRANTOR.

In construing this easement and where the context so requires, the singular includes the plural and all grammatical changes shall be implied to make the provisions hereof apply equally to corporations and to individuals.

EXHIBIT "A"

A 30 foot easement for ingress and egress and installation of a water line over grantor's real property extending from that property described in fee 82-34858, south to Henrici Road, being located in the southwest one-quarter of the northwest one-quarter of section 14, Township 3 south, Range 2 east, of the Willamette Meridian, in the County of Clackamas, State of Oregon,

more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a point in the west line of section 14, Township 3 South, Range 2 East, of the Willamette Meridian, which is 495 feet south of the northwest corner of the southwest one-quarter of the northwest one quarter of said section, said point being the southwest corner of that tract described in deed to Daniel Williams, recorded August 23, 1886, in book 27, page 602, deed records; THENCE continuing south 00° 57' 53" west, along said west line 185.00 feet, to the south west corner of that particular deed in Clackamas County Deed Records, fee no. 82-34858; THENCE South 88° 50' 54" east, along the south line of said fee 82-34858, said point being the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING of the easement to be described; THENCE along a line parallel to the west line of said section 14, south 00° 57' 53" west, 619.80 feet, more or less, to the north right of way line, 30 feet; THENCE parallel to the west line of said section 14, north 00° 57' 53" east, 619.77 feet, more or less, to the south east corner of less, to the south east corner or less, to the south east corner of fee 82-34858; THENCE north 88° 50' 54" west, along the south line of said fee no. 82-34858, 30 feet to the point of beginning.
