PUBLIC UTILITY EASEMENT "C" TRUNK

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that CLACKAMAS COMMUNITY COLLEGE, acting by its Board of Directors, hereinafter called the Grantor, does hereby grant unto the CITY OF OREGON CITY, hereinafter called the CITY, it successors in interest and assigns, an easement and right-of-way to construct, reconstruct, operate and maintain a sanitary sewer on the following described land:

See Exhibits attached hereto as follows:

GRANTOR reserves the right to use the surface of the land for walkways, plantings, parking and related uses. Such uses undertaken by the GRANTOR shall not be inconsistent or interfere with the use of the subject easement area by the City. No building or utility shall be placed upon, under or within the property subject to the foregoing easement during the term thereof; however, without the written permission of the CITY.

Upon completion of the construction, the CITY shall restore the surface of the property to its original condition and shall indemnify and hold the GRANTOR harmless against any and all loss, cost or damage arising out of the exercise of the rights granted herein.

The true consideration of this conveyance is one and no/100 dollars - (\$1.00) - the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by GRANTOR.

In construing this conveyance and where the context so requires, the singular includes the plural and all grammatical changes shall be implied to make the provisions hereof apply equally to corporations and individuals.

EXHIBIT "A"

A parcel of land in the southeast quarter of Section 8, T. 3 S., R. 2 E., W.M., Clackamas County, Oregon, being a portion of that tract of land described in deed to Clackamas Community College, a municipal corporation of the State of Oregon, recorded January 6, 1969, Clackamas County Deed Record Fee No. 69-00162, described as follows:

Beginning at Engineers Station "C" 70016+00, 90 feet left; thence along the northerly right-of-way line of Molalla Avenue N. 68* 46' 15" W., 63.99 feet; thence N. 88* 17' 59" E., 99.65 feet to the westerly right-of-way line of Cascade Highway South (Highway 213); thence along said right-of-way line S. 56* 49' 20" W., 47.74 feet to the point-of-beginning.
