WHEREAS, the City of Hillsboro has heretofore gone on record as favoring Legislation providing for the allocation of a Dollar and one-half (\$1.50) per capita to Hillsboro for Street purposes; and


WHEREAS, recent publicity has stated that the Cities of Oregon have abandoned their attempts to obtain said allocation; and

WHEREAS, said report is not true inasmuch as said allocation is highly necessary for the proper maintenance of our Streets and Highways;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF HILLSBORO That the City go on record as favoring the enactment of appropriate Legislation providing for the allocation from the Highway Funds of the State of Oregon of a Dollar and one-half (\$1.50) per capita to each City and Town in the State for use by said City and Town for Street and Highway purposes;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF HILLSBORO That copies of this Resolution be sent to the Washington County Legislative Delegation with the request that they work for the enactment of this Legislation and place this Resolution before the proper Committee to obtain the same.
