

RESOLUTION OF-INTENTION TO IMPROVE

WHEREAS, South Fifth Street from Oak Street south to Cedar Street has never been improved sufficiently to carry traffic the year round with any degree of efficiency and economy, and

WHEREAS due to increased industrial development in the southern part of the City of Hillsboro it is reasonable to anticipate a heavy increase in traffic within the year, and

WHEREAS it is impossible to adequately and economically maintain the street in its present state;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF HILLSBORO, That the City of Hillsboro, Washington County, Oregon, proceed to improve South Fifth Street between the South line of Oak Street and the centerline of Cedar Street in the following manner, to-wit: From the South line of Oak Street to the center of Walnut Street, excavate to proper street grade between sidewalks, construct concrete curbs 13.0 feet each side of the center of said street, construct a macadam surface 26 feet in width with a minimum thickness of 7 inches, extend sidewalks to the curbs where walks do not exist, provide for driveways, provide for proper drainage and for such other work as will make a workmanlike improvement. From the centerline of Walnut Street to the centerline of Cedar Street, excavate between sidewalks to proper street grade, to a minimum width of thirty feet, to construct thereon a macadamized surface not less than twenty feet in width with a minimum thickness of 7 inches, provide for driveways and proper drainage and such other work as will make a workmanlike improvement, and assess the costs of such improvements to the abutting properties in accordance with the provisions of the City Charter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That written objections and remonstrances to said proposed Street improvement may be made or filed at any time on or before 3 o'clock p.m. on the 2nd day of May, 1939, at the City Hall at Hillsboro, Oregon;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That the Recorder is authorized to give notice of this Resolution in the manner provided by the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Hillsboro and the City Engineer shall post the notice of said improvement as required by the Charter and Ordinances in the manner therein set forth.
