

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, The City Planning Commission has filed with the City Clerk a report recommending a change in the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Hillsboro, being ordinance number 1041, passed and approved by the Council on the 15th day of July, 1936; and

WHEREAS it is necessary that the Council afford an opportunity for a public hearing before acting upon said recommended changed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED That Tuesday, the 2nd day of May, 1939, at the hour of 8 o'clock p.m. in the Council Chambers in the City Hall, Hillsboro, Oregon, be and hereby is fixed as the time and place for the hearing of objections to the proposed amendments to Ordinance Number 1041 of the City of Hillsboro.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That the City Recorder be and he hereby is ordered and directed to publish notice of this hearing in the Hillsboro Argus in the issues of said paper to be dated April 20, 1939, and April 27, 1939, setting forth in said notice the time and place of hearing and in substance the changes to be made.
