

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO IMPROVE

WHEREAS, There has been filed with the City Recorder a petition signed by more than 60% of the owners of the property upon that portion of North Fifth Avenue hereinafter described, which petition requests an improvement be made on said Street as hereinafter set forth; and


WHEREAS, it is manditory upon the Council to act upon said Resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF HILLSBORO That the City of Hillsboro, Washington County, Oregon, proceed to improve North Fifth Avenue from a point eight feet north of the center line of East Edison Street to the south line of East Grant Street extended easterly, as follows: By excavating said street to a proper grade and macadamize the same to a width of twenty (20) feet and a thickness of seven (7) inches; provide proper drainage, and do such other work as will make a workmanlike improvement and assess the cost of such improvement to the abutting properties in accordance with the provisions of the City Charter.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That written objections and remonstrances to said proposed Street improvement may be made or filed at any time on or before 8 o'clock p.m. on the 5th day of September, 1939, at the City Hall at Hillsboro, Oregon.

Be IT FURTHER RESOLVED That the City Recorder is authorized to give notice of this Resolution in the manner provided by the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Hillsboro and the City Engineer shall post the notice of said improvement as required by the Charter and Ordinances in the manner therein set forth.
