

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO OPEN
NINTH STREET BETWEEN OAK AND
WALNUT STREETS
- - - - -

WHEREAS, The City of Hillsboro owns the land within the boundaries of Ninth Street between Oak and Walnut Streets and the City Engineer has filed a report on said street showing the beginning and termination and width thereof and also certifying that the City owns the land to be dedicated; and

WHEREAS, The City Council desires to open said street as a street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF HILLSBORO, that the City proceed to open and dedicate as a street the following described portion of Ninth Street, to-wit:

A strip of land 60.0 feet in width being 30.0 feet on each side of the following described centerline;

Beginning at the intersection of the South line of Oak Street and the centerline of South Ninth Avenue in the City of Hillsboro, Washington County, Oregon, and running thence South, parallel to and 30.0 feet Westerly from the West line of Block "A", Fairview Addition to the City of Hillsboro, 396.0 feet more or less to and terminating at the North line of Walnut Street.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That Tuesday, the 5th day of December, 1939, at the hour of 8 o'clock p.m. in the Council Chambers in the City Hall in Hillsboro, Oregon, be and hereby is fixed as the time and place for the hearing of any objections or remonstrances to the dedicating of that portion of Ninth Street hereinabove described.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City Recorder be and he hereby is authorized and instructed to publish a notice of said hearing in one

issue of the Hillsboro Argus, a weekly newspaper printed and published in Hillsboro, Oregon, prior to the date of said hearing.

Description of 9th Street between Oak and Walnut.


A strip of land 60.0 feet in width being 30.0 feet on each side of the following described centerline;
