

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO IMPROVE

WHEREAS, South Ninth Avenue between East Oak Street and East Walnut Street has never been improved, and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council of the City of Hillsboro, that the same should be improved by grading to the proper street grade and surfaced with crushed rock or gravel of sufficient width and thickness to make a permanent and durable roadbed that will accommodate traffic at all seasons of the year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF HILLSBORO, that the City of Hillsboro, Washington County, Oregon, proceed to improve South Ninth Avenue between a point 9 feet south of the center line of East Oak Street and a point 8 feet north of the center line of East Walnut Street in the following manner, to-wit: Excavating to proper street grade for a width of 15 feet on each side of the center line of said South Ninth Avenue, constructing thereon a crushed rock or gravel macadam not less than twenty (20) feet in width and eight (8) inches in thickness, providing for proper drainage and such other work as will make a good and workmanlike improvement, and assess the cost of such improvement to the abutting properties in accordance with the provisions of the City Charter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that written objections and remonstrances to said proposed street improvement may be made or filed at anytime on or before 8 o'clock p.m. on the 2nd day of January, 1940, at the City Hall at Hillsboro, Oregon.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Recorder is authorized to give notice of this Resolution in the manner provided by the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Hillsboro, and the City Engineer shall post the notice of said improvement as required by the Charter and Ordinances in the manner therein set forth.
