

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO IMPROVE
FIRST STREET FROM THE CENTER LINE
OF MAIN STREET NORTHERLY TO THE
NORTH LINE OF JACKSON STREET AS
HEREIN PROVIDED

Whereas, First Street as now improved does not provide adequate passageway for the traffic flowing into and from the City to the main county road serving the City on the Northwesterly boundary thereof; and

Whereas, the County Court of Washington County, Oregon, and the City of Hillsboro have entered into an agreement whereby the County will contribute \$500.00 to the cost of properly widening and improving said street and the balance of said cost is to be paid out of the General Road Fund of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF HILLSBORO That the City of Hillsboro, Washington County, Oregon, proceed to improve First Street from the center line of Main Street Northerly to the North line of Jackson Street as follows:

Widen said Street between Main and Lincoln Street four feet on the West side and six feet on the East side, making a total new width of thirty-six feet and widen said street between Lincoln Street and Jackson Street five feet on each side, making a total new width between the curbs of thirty-two feet. Said widened portions to be surfaced with crushed rock base and a two-inch asphaltic surface, construct new concrete curbs, re-construct concrete driveways where the same will be destroyed by said widening, move and re-construct drainage facilities and to do such other work as will make a good and workman-like improvement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That the cost of said improvement is to be paid out of the General Road Fund of the City of Hillsboro, except the sum of \$500.00, which is to be paid by Washington County, Oregon, pursuant to a contract and agreement existing between the County and the City.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That written objections and remonstrances

to said proposed street improvement may be made or filed at any time on or before 8 o'clock p.m. on the 2nd day of April, 1940, at the City Hall at Hillsboro, Oregon.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That the Recorder is authorized to give notice of this Resolution in the manner provided by the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Hillsboro and the City Engineer shall post the notice of said improvement as required by the Charter and Ordinances in the manner therein set forth.
