

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO IMPROVE

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WHEREAS, There has been filed with the City Recorder a petition signed by more than 60% of the owners of the property upon that portion of East Grant Street hereinafter described, which petition requests an improvement to be made on said street as hereinafter set forth; and

WHEREAS, It is mandatory upon the Council to act upon said Resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF HILLSBORO, That the City of Hillsboro, Washington County, Oregon, proceed to improve East Grant Street from a point 8 feet east of the centerline of North First Avenue to the centerline of North Second Avenue as follows:


by excavating and grading said street to a proper grade for a width of 26 feet, constructing concrete curbs thirteen feet each side of the centerline and extending concrete curbs on the proper radius curve at each street intersection, extending cross walks to the curb where they do not at this time exist, macadamize said street between curbs with a crushed rock or gravel macadam twenty six feet in width and eight inches in depth (loose measure), provide for proper and adequate drainage and such other work as will make said improvement a good and workmanlike job.

and assess the cost of such improvement to the abutting properties in accordance with the provisions of the City Charter;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That written objections and remonstrances to said proposed street improvement may be made or filed at any time on or before 8:00 o'clock p.m. on the Second day of April, 1940, at the City Hall at Hillsboro, Oregon.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Recorder is authorized to give notice of this resolution in the manner provided by the Charter and ordinances of the City of Hillsboro and the City Engineer shall post the notice of said improvement as required by the Charter and ordinances in the manner therein set forth.
