

RESOLUTION # 3

BEFORE THE UTILITIES COMMISSION
OF THE CITY OF HILLSBORO, OREGON

SUBJECT: WATER HYDRANT SERVICE CHARGE WITHIN THE CITY
OF HILLSBORO

Whereas, at the time the Water System was purchased by the City of Hillsboro from the Peoples Water and Gas Company, the matter of the monthly service charge for Fire Hydrants within the City was in a controversial state, to-wit: the fixed charge by the Water Company was \$3.50 per month per hydrant and the payment established by City ordinance and offered by the City was \$0.87½ per hydrant per month, and

Whereas, the \$0.87½ rate has continued in effect since the date of said purchase, and

Whereas, The Utilities Commission is authorized and empowered by section 255 of the City Charter of the City of Hillsboro to establish rates for the use of water within the City and outside of the City, and

Whereas, the Commission is of the opinion that the hydrant rental rate now in effect is not sufficient to defray the cost of this particular service,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HILLSBORO, that on and after January 1, 1941, the rate to be charged to the City of Hillsboro for Hydrant Rental Service shall be \$1.00 per hydrant per month.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution be submitted to the City Council of the City of Hillsboro for approval at its next regular meeting.
