WHEREAS, public employees take not only jobs, but oaths; and



WHEREAS, day in and day out they provide the diverse services required by the American people of their government with efficiency and integrity; and


WHEREAS, without these public servants at every level, continuity would be impossible in a democracy that regularly changes its leaders and elected officials.
