

PROCLAMATION

Designating the Oregon City High School Robotics Team as
Ambassadors for the City

- Whereas** The Oregon City High School Robotics Team had six weeks to design, build and program a full-sized robot that was judged on how well it raced around a track and handled a ball; and
- Whereas** The Robotics team built Trifecta, a 10.5 ft tall 105 pound robot with aluminum rods, pneumatic pistons and a brain full of colored wires and multidirectional wheels; and
- Whereas** Trifecta helped the Robotics Team place 3rd out of 55 teams from Oregon, Washington, California, Idaho, Montana, Michigan, Hawaii, and Canada; and
- Whereas** This talented team won the Rookie All-Star award by being the most outstanding rookie team at the tournament (winning over Jesuit, LO and Gresham plus 7 other teams), in front of a crowd of 3,000 people; and
- Whereas** By winning this honor and award, the Robotics Team will advance to the World Festival in Atlanta, Georgia; and
- Whereas** This outstanding team, consisting of 18 students, 2 coaches and parent chaperones, is raising money to go to Atlanta for a week of competition; and
- Whereas** this team will represent the City of Oregon City as well as Oregon City School District.

Now, Therefore, I, Alice Norris, mayor of Oregon City, do hereby designate the Oregon City Pioneer Robotics Team as official ambassadors of Oregon City during the World Championship Festival in Atlanta, and we expect you to fulfill this special honor by bestowing friendship, respect, and good sportsmanship during your ambassadorship thereof. And I further urge that the citizens of Oregon City send good will, good luck, and financial contributions with these science and technology students as they embark on this important mission.
