WHEREAS, more than 58,000 men and women lost their lives on the battlefields of Vietnam defending the ideals on which the United States of America was founded; and

WHEREAS, in 1982, our Nation built a monument to the lives lost, the survivors and the unresolved feelings; and

WHEREAS, many people will never have the chance to visit the monument in Washington, D.C., to begin to resolve their personal feelings; and

WHEREAS, Lincoln Memorial Park is bringing to Portland, on November 6, 7 and 8, 1992, a 250-foot replica of the Vietnam Veterans Memorial that will allow our citizens to experience the intense human emotion associated with the monument.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, DANIEL W. FOWLER, Mayor of the City of Oregon City, Oregon, hereby proclaims Saturday, November 7, 1992 as:

"VIETNAM VETERANS DAY"
