- whereas, philanthropy—the love of humanity—requires donors to make wise choices in giving to achieve the maximum good through their gifts; and
- WHEREAS, true philanthropists inspire others by their example to contribute to the wellbeing of Oregon City; and
- WHEREAS, the Oregon Chapter of the National Society of Fund Raising Executives will honor outstanding Oregon philanthropists at the Philanthropy Day Conference in the Oregon Convention Center on November 13, 1990.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, DAVID D. SPEAR, Mayor of the City of Oregon City do hereby declare November 13, 1990, as:
