Subject: Tri-City Service District -Temporary Construction Easement Report No. 89-49

2-2E-30 TL 600

On the April 5, 1989 City Commission agenda, there is a temporary construction easement for a Bank Protection Project in Clackamette Park for Commission approval. During the construction of the Tri-City Waste Treatment Plant Project, an outfall line was constructed through Clackamette Park to the Willamette River.

Erosion of the bank has been occuring at the outfall and bank stabilization and protection needs to be done. Tri-City Service District is proposing a construction project to stabilize the bank at the outfall and needs a temporary construction easement from the City to do the work. Attached is a copy of the easement for Commission review.

The Development Services Department has reviewed the plans and specifications for the Project and added provisions regarding restoration of any damage to property and landscaping. Provisions were also added for City indemnification.

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the temporary construction easement and authorize the Mayor and City Recorder to execute respectively.
