

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON AMENDING
ORDINANCE 1752, SECTION 2, BY EXPANDING THE DEFINITION OF
CURBSIDE TO INCLUDE ROADSIDE.**

WHEREAS, as defined in Ordinance # 1752 : “Curbside” applies only to recycling and yard debris collection and refers to containers being located within three (3) feet of the edge of a public street, and

WHEREAS, not all areas of the city have “curbs” and the term curbside has created some confusion among garbage customers and their collectors, and

WHEREAS, the franchisees have requested clarification of the term “curbside”;

NOW THEREFORE the City Council of the City of Milwaukie does ordain as follows:


The first sentence of Ordinance # 1752, Section 2 (f) is amended as follows:

“Curbside”, as defined here, may also be called
“**curbside/roadside**” and applies only to recycling
and yard debris collection and refers to containers
being located within three (3) feet of the edge of the
public street.

Read for the first time on July 16, 1996, and moved to second reading
by a unanimous vote of the City Council.

Read the second time and adopted by the City Council on July 16, 1996.
