

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, AMENDING SECTION 2.04.140(A) OF THE MILWAUKIE MUNICIPAL CODE AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1779.

WHEREAS, Section 20 of the City Charter requires the Council to adopt rules governing its meetings and procedures by general ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that the following modification to the order of business will meet the requirements of the Charter and provide for fair and efficient conduct of Council business.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 2.04.140(A) of the Milwaukie Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:


A. All regular meetings shall have the following order of business:

1. Call to order;
2. Proclamations, Commendations, Special Reports and Awards;
3. Consent Agenda;
4. Audience participation (for items not on the agenda);
5. Public Hearings;
6. Other Business;
7. Information Items;
8. Adjournment of Regular Session;
9. Executive Sessions, as necessary.


Read for the first time on November 7, 1995, and moved to second reading by unanimous vote of the City Council.

Read the second time and adopted by the City Council on November 7, 1995.
