

ORDINANCE NO. 1739

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, ADOPTING CHAPTER 2.44 BY CREATING THE POSITION OF FIRE MARSHAL FOR THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE FIRE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Milwaukie, for the City of Milwaukie Fire Department, a Municipal Fire Department, hereinafter referred to as the "Department", adopts fire safety regulations; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council requires that said regulation be enforced to provide minimum fire safety for the citizens of the City; now, therefore,

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Establishment of Fire Marshal Office.

There is hereby established the office of City Fire Marshall.

Section 2. Duties and Powers.

The fire codes and other regulations as adopted by the Department shall be enforced by the Fire Marshal's Office. The Fire Marshal's Office shall be the law enforcement agency of the Department which shall operate under the supervision of the Chief of the Department.

Section 3. Assignment of Personnel.

- A. The Fire Marshal in charge of the Fire Marshal's Office shall be appointed by the Chief of the Department on the basis of examination to determine his or her qualifications.
- B. The Chief of the Department may assign certain employees of the Department as Deputy Fire Marshals from time to time as necessary. The Chief of the Department may recommend to the City Council the employment of Technical Inspectors who, when such authorization is made, shall be selected through an examination to determine their fitness for the position.

Read the first time on June 15, 1993, 1993, and moved to a second reading by unanimous vote of the City Council.

Read the second time and adopted by the City Council on June 15, 1993.
