## ordinance no. <u>1691</u>

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, ADOPTING THE NORTH CLACKAMAS URBAN AREA PUBLIC FACILITIES PLAN AS AN ANCILLARY DOCUMENT TO THE MILWAUKIE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN.

WHEREAS, the City of Milwaukie Comprehensive Plan was updated effective December 7, 1989, as part of a Periodic Review Process; and

WHEREAS, a requirement for said Periodic Review Process was adoption of a Public Facilities Plan for guiding future public service improvements and service provision in unincorporated land within the City's Urban Growth Management Boundary; and

WHEREAS, the North Clackamas Urban Area Public Facilities Plan was reviewed at work sessions and at a public hearing by the Milwaukie Planning Commission, said Commission on October 9, 1990, unanimously recommending adoption of the North Clackamas Urban Area Facilities Plan;

## NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Findings. The following findings are adopted:

## FINDINGS:

- The North Clackamas Urban Area Public Facilities Plan provides a framework for considering how specific public facilities and services can be provided within Milwaukie's Urban Growth Management Boundary, and is therefore consistent with the requirements of ORS 197.712.
- 2. It is in the City of Milwaukie's interest to define the City's role as a service provider within the general North Clackamas area, and to define its responsibilities in providing cost effective and coordinated services within the Urban Growth Management Boundary area in the future.
- 3. The City of Milwaukie and Clackamas County's interests are served by establishing processes and procedures whereby issues of regionalization and/or various interjurisdictional service delivery arrangements can be explored, and said Public Facilities Plan provides a framework for continued coordination.
- 4. The procedure stipulated in Section D of the Urban Growth Management Agreement provides the structure in which amendments and refinements to the North Clackamas Urban Area Public Facilities Plan can be considered and subsequently adapted.
- 5. Adoption of the North Clackamas Urban Area Public Facilities Plan is consistent with Objective #2, Policies 1 and 2; and Objective #3, Policy 1 of the Public Facilities and Services Element of the Milwaukie Comprehensive Plan.
- 6. Adoption of the North Clackamas Urban Area Public Facilities Plan is an action agreed to in the Urban Growth Boundary Management Agreement signed by the City of Milwaukie and Clackamas County on July 5, 1990.

Section 2. Adoption. The North Clackamas Urban Area Public Facilities Plan, consisting of four volumes titled "Sanitary Sewerage Services", "Water Systems", Transportation Element", and "Storm Drainage Element", is hereby adopted as an ancillary document to the Milwaukie Comprehensive Plan.
