

ORDINANCE NO. 1680

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON AMENDING CHAPTER 10 OF THE MILWAUKIE MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING A NEW PROVISION DEFINING PREMISES OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AND BY AMENDING THE PROVISION REGARDING PROHIBITED PARKING.

WHEREAS, Section 10.04 generally defines vehicle and traffic terms; and

WHEREAS, Section 10.20.060(B)(13) defines prohibited parking on City-owned or City-operated property; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to make the best use of City streets in the public interest; now, therefore:

THE CITY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: There is hereby added to the Municipal Code of Milwaukie Chapter 10.04.305, which is to read as follows:

"Section 10.04.305 Premises Open to the Public

"Premises open to the Public" includes any premises owned or maintained by the City of Milwaukie and open to the general public for the use of motor vehicles, whether or not a fee is charged for the use of the premises.

Section 2: Section 10.20.060(B)(13) of the Milwaukie Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

"On premises open to the public if there is in plain view on such premises a sign prohibiting or restricting parking thereon."

Read for the first time on May 1, 1990, and moved to second reading by 5-0 vote of the City Council.

Read the second time and adopted by the City Council on May 1, 1990.

Signed by the Mayor on May 1, 1990.




