ORDINANCE NO. 1654

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON AMENDING THE MILWAUKIE MUNICIPAL CODE.

WHEREAS, the Milwaukie Municipal Code provides the authority to set fees and;

WHEREAS, the fees are to be set by resolution.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Milwaukie Municipal Code Chapter 5.20 Coinoperated Machines and 5.28 Poolrooms and Billiard Rooms are repealed.

Section 2. The following Milwaukie Municipal Code sections shall be amended to read as follows:

5.12.060. Application for employee permit.

A. & B. remain unchanged.

C. A single application may be made for any combination of permits that may be applied for under this section, provided that the fee for such a combination permit shall be paid for each type of activity. Such fee shall be set by resolution of the City Council.

5.12.070 Permit fee.

- A. Every applicant for a permit to maintain, operate or conduct a business regulated under this chapter shall file an application with the chief of police and a nonrefundable fee established by resolution of City Council shall be paid.
- B. Every applicant for a permit to engage in the practice of nude modeling, relaxation treatment, sex counseling, sexy dancing or sexy reading, or to be employed by a sexual encounter center or sexy sauna or bathhouse business shall file an application with the chief of police and pay a nonrefundable fee established by resolution of City Council.

5.32.080 License--Fees.

A. License fees shall be established by resolution of City Council. The schedule shall be established on a basis to substantially defray the direct and indirect costs to the city in investigating applicants, monitoring the security service business and administering the provisions of this chapter.

B. Repealed.

8.16.040 False alarms.

A. For each false alarm over [five] three in a permit year, the holder of a permit shall pay a fee as established by the city council upon written demand by the police chief.

B. Remains unchanged.

12.20.070 Permit--Fee. Every application for a permit to install any bench shall be accompanied by proof of payment of the fee established by city council resolution, which shall cover the entire cost for the remainder of the fiscal year of the city, that terminates on July 1st of each year, which such fee shall be in addition to the annual license fees to do business in the city.

Read the first time on May 2, 1989, and moved to second reading by 3-0 vote of the City Council.

Read the second time and adopted by the City Council on $\,^{\rm May}$ 16 , 1989.
