

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1641

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, PROVIDING FOR ELECTION ON INITIATIVE AND REFERENDUM MEASURES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Whereas, state law permits the City to establish rules regarding the holding of elections on initiative and referendum measures, and

Whereas, the Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City to have initiative and referendum measures voted on as early as possible, therefore

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Milwaukie Code Chap. 2.32 is amended by adding new Section 2.32.030 as follows:

2.32.030. **Election dates for initiative and referendum measures.** Initiative and referendum measures will be submitted to the voters at the next available election date.

Section 2. Because there is a referendum measure pending which specifies an early election date, the Council finds that passage of this ordinance is necessary for the immediate peace, health, safety, and welfare of the community. An emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage by the Council.

Read the first time on January 19, 1988, and moved to second reading by unanimous vote of the City Council.

Read the second time and adopted by the City Council on January 19, 1988.

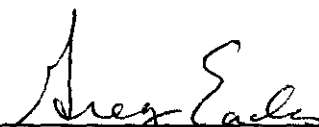
