A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE CITY OF OREGON CITY'S LOCAL GOVERNMENT GRANT APPLICATION FOR DEVELOPMENT OF THE GLEN OAK PARK AND AUTHORIZING THE COMMUNITY SERVICES DIRECTOR TO SIGN THE APPLICATION AS THE CITY'S DELEGATE

WHEREAS, the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department is accepting applications for the Local Government Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oregon City, through it's Parks and Recreation Department, desires to participate in this grant program to the greatest extent possible as a means of providing needed park and recreation acquisitions, improvements and enhancements; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has identified park improvements at Glen Oak Park as a high priority need in the City of Oregon City; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of Oregon City have identified accessible parking and large open turf areas, a dog park, trails, a nature play area, and landscape improvements as a high priority through the Park Master Plan process; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oregon City has available local matching funds to fulfill its share of obligations related to this grant application should the grant funds be awarded; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oregon City will provide adequate funding for on-going operations and maintenance of this park and recreation facility should the grant funds be awarded.

NOW, THEREFORE, OREGON CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The City Commission demonstrates its support for the submittal of a grant application to the Oregon Park and Recreation Department for development of Glen Oak Park.
