**WHEREAS**, the Milwaukie Police Department celebrated its 100<sup>th</sup> year of providing exceptional customer service to the people of Milwaukie; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department remains dedicated and steadfast in its commitment to proudly serve the citizens of Milwaukie, using philosophies of community/police partnerships, pro-active crime prevention strategies, citizen and community input, and constant introspection; and

**WHEREAS**, since the first recorded death in 1791, more than 20,000 Law Enforcement Officers in the United States have made the ultimate sacrifice in the line of duty, including Sgt. James Worell of the Milwaukie Police Department on December 31<sup>st</sup>, 1953; and

**WHEREAS**, there have already been 32 officers killed in the line of duty in the first quarter of 2017 across the nation; and

**WHEREAS**, the Citizens of Milwaukie wish to express their greatest appreciation for the sacrifice and service of those officers; and

**WHEREAS**, the Citizens of Milwaukie also value and appreciate the integrity and dedication of our sworn officers.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Mark Gamba, Mayor of the City of Milwaukie, a municipal corporation in the County of Clackamas, in the State of Oregon, do hereby proclaim that the citizens of Milwaukie recognize and support **National Police Week** May 14<sup>th</sup> through May 20<sup>th</sup>, 2017.
