WHEREAS, National Public Works Week was instituted in 1960 by the American Public Works Association to call attention to the importance of public works programs supporting local communities, and the United States Senate passed a resolution affirming the first National Public Works Week; and



NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE CITY OF WEST LINN, that May 21 – 27, 2017 is:


