

RESOLUTION NO. 19-2011

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, APPROVING THE PROPOSED MERGER OF MEL DEINES SANITARY SERVICE, INC. AND P. DEINES SANITARY SERVICES, INC. TO RESULT IN 100% OWNERSHIP BY MEL DEINES SANITARY SERVICE, INC. AND AMENDING RESOLUTION 56-2005 AND THE SOLID WASTE SERVICE AREA MAP TO REFLECT THIS CHANGE.

WHEREAS, Mel Deines Sanitary Service has been franchised and providing garbage and recycling services to customers in Garbage Collection Area 1 and portions of Area 4 in the City of Milwaukie for over 30 years; and

WHEREAS, Mel Deines Sanitary has requested a transfer of Area 4 to their company as a result of a merger of P.Deines and Mel Deines Sanitary Services;

WHEREAS, Milwaukie City Code section 13.24.130, Transfer of Franchise, describes the requirements for transfer of franchises and Mel Deines has met all those requirements; and

WHEREAS, the City's review of financial and technical documents submitted by Mel Deines Sanitary Service and their accounting consultants indicate that they have the knowledge, experience and financial resources to meet all obligations of a garbage franchisee;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

Section 1: The transfer of Solid Waste Franchise Area 4 to Mel Deines Sanitary Services is hereby granted.


Section 2: The list of franchised haulers in the City of Milwaukie, adopted by Resolution 56-2005, shall be replaced with the following:

Hoodview Disposal and Recycling
Mel Deines Sanitary Service, Inc.
Oak Grove Disposal Co..
Waste Management of Oregon, Inc.
Wichita Sanitary Service

Section 3: The Map of the Solid Waste Franchise Service Areas of the City of Milwaukie, also adopted by Resolution 56-2005, shall be amended to list Mel Deines Sanitary Services as the service provider for Area 4.


