

RESOLUTION NO. 71-2010

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, REAPPOINTING PAT DUVAL AS MANAGER PRO TEM FOR UP TO THREE MONTHS EFFECTIVE SEPTEMBER 2, 2010

WHEREAS, the position of City Manager became vacant when the city's employment contract with Mike Swanson concluded on February 28, 2010; and

WHEREAS, Section 27(b) of the Milwaukie Charter states that upon any vacancy occurring in the office of manager the council shall at its next meeting adopt a resolution of its intention to appoint another manager; and

WHEREAS, the Charter further provides that appointment of a manager shall take place within a reasonable time after the adoption of the resolution of intention to fill the vacancy; and

WHEREAS, Section 27(e) of the Charter authorizes the council to appoint a manager pro tem during the interim when the council is seeking a manager; charging the manager pro tem with the powers and right to discharge the duties of the manager during a term of up to six months, and

WHEREAS, the City Council passed Resolution 20-2010 on March 2, 2010 declaring its intention to appoint another city manager and appointing Pat DuVal as manager pro tem until a city manager is appointed or for a term up to six month, or until another individual is appointed by council as manager pro tem, and

WHEREAS, the City Council is in the process of reviewing candidates for the position of manager but likely will not complete the selection process prior to the end of the six month term of the manager pro tem, and

WHEREAS, Section 27(e) of the Charter authorizes the City Council at the end of the six month term to reappoint the manager pro tem for up to an additional three months.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council, City of Milwaukie, State of Oregon, pursuant to Milwaukie Charter Sections 27(e):

Section 1. Reappoints Pat DuVal as manager pro tem for up to an additional three month period or until an individual appointed by the City Council assumes the position of manager.

Section 2. The period of appointment begins on September 2, 2010 and extends until no later than December 1, 2010.

Section 3. This resolution is effective immediately upon passage.


