

RESOLUTION NO. 17-30

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING ANNUAL INFLATIONARY ADJUSTMENTS TO THE RATES CHARGED FOR STORM DRAINAGE SERVICES

WHEREAS, Oregon City Municipal Code Section 13.16.050 provides that the City Commission may amend storm drainage rates by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 12-18 in June of 2012, establishing inflationary adjustments for storm drainage rates with an expiration date of January 1, 2017; and


WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to adjust rates annually for the effects of inflation so as not to unnecessarily burden customers with unpredictable large rate increases.

NOW, THEREFORE, OREGON CITY RESOLVES:

Section 1. Effective January 1, 2018, and annually thereafter, the rates charged for storm drainage services shall be adjusted to account for inflation in an amount of no more than three percent (3%) per year.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Commission.

Approved and adopted at a regular meeting of the City Commission held on the 6th day of December 2017.




