

PROCLAMATION

I, Alan K. Brickley, Mayor of the City of West Linn, Clackamas County, Oregon, do hereby proclaim and declare the measure allowing a levy of \$383,146.00 in excess of the constitutional six percent limitation, submitted to the legal voters of said city for their adoption or rejection at a special election held in said city on Tuesday, the 29th day of April, 1975, which measure reads as follows:

"A measure allowing a levy of \$383,146.00 in excess of the constitutional six percent limitation, which amount is required, and will be used, to meet the cost of operation of the departments and functions of the City of West Linn, Oregon for Fiscal Year 1975-76."

and the measure appeared on the official ballot at said election and was designated by the following ballot title, to-wit:

"PROPOSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF WEST LINN, OREGON a measure allowing a levy of \$383,146.00 in excess of the constitutional six percent limitation, which amount is required, and will be used, to meet the cost of operation of the departments and functions of the City of West Linn, Oregon for Fiscal Year 1975-76.

"If this measure is approved, the operating budget to be financed by local taxes for the year 1975-76 will be \$129,905.00 more than the operating budget financed by local taxes for the preceding year.




I, therefore, proclaim and declare that said measure is adopted, duly approved, and duly passed by the legal voters of the City of West Linn.
