A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, TO SUPPORT NET NEUTRALITY.

WHEREAS, On December 14, 2017 the FCC passed a rule "Restoring Internet Freedom" which repealed Net Neutrality protections; and

WHEREAS, the rule was published in the Federal Register on February 22, 2018; and will be effective on April 23, 2018; and


WHEREAS, the Milwaukie City Council recognizes this ruling will have a negative impact on the City of Milwaukie, it's residents and businesses; and

Now, Therefore, be it Resolved that the Milwaukie City Council supports overturning this ruling.

Be it Further Resolved that the Milwaukie City Council authorizes the Mayor and staff to endorse legislation, letters, or efforts to overturn this ruling; and that failing the overturn of this ruling, the Milwaukie City Council will explore alternative methods to secure access to critical, unfettered, high speed internet service for our residents.

Introduced and adopted by the City Council on 3/20/18.




