RESOLUTION NO. 18-15

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING ELIGIBILITY TO RECEIVE STATE SHARED REVENUES

WHEREAS, ORS 221.760(1) provides as follows:

SECTION 1. The officer responsible for disbursing funds to cities under ORS 323.455, 366.785 to 366.820 and 471.805 shall, in the case of a city located within a county having more than 100,000 inhabitants according to the most recent federal decennial census, disburse such funds only if the city provides four or more of the following services:

- 1. Police Protection
- 2. Fire Protection
- 3. Street construction, maintenance and lighting
- 4. Sanitary sewer
- 5. Storm sewers
- 6. Planning, zoning, and subdivision control
- 7. One or more utility services; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to establish compliance with ORS 221.760(1) by certifying the provision of municipal services;

NOW, THEREFORE, OREGON CITY RESOLVES that the City of Oregon City, Oregon, hereby certifies that it provides the following four or more municipal services enumerated in ORS 221.760(1):

- 1. Police protection
- 2. Street construction, maintenance, and lighting
- 3. Sanitary sewer
- 4. Storm sewers
- 5. Planning, zoning, and subdivision control
- 6. One or more utility services

This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Commission.
