**WHEREAS**, the American Legion has become a pre-eminent community service organization working to support programs that benefit our nation's veterans, service members, and their families; and


**WHEREAS**, Legionnaires uphold the ideals of freedom and democracy while working to make a difference in the lives of all Americans; and

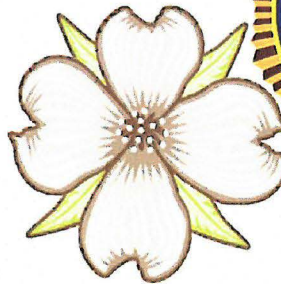
