#### **RESOLUTION NO. 18-41**

#### A RESOLUTION ADJUSTING SOLID WASTE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL RATES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2019

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 06-1001 was adopted February 1, 2006, and under said Ordinance, an agreement was entered into between the City of Oregon City and Oregon City Garbage Company, Inc. (dba B&B Leasing) for a Solid Waste Collection and Disposal Franchise; and

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 8.20.130 of the Oregon City Municipal Code, provides that rates shall be approved by the City Commission and established by resolution; and

**WHEREAS**, the Franchisee is currently requesting a rate increase due to increased costs of recycling.

NOW, THEREFORE, OREGON CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** The Rate for Solid Waste Services provided by Oregon City Garbage Company, Inc. (dba B&B Leasing), an Oregon Corporation, shall be set forth in the attached Exhibit B and said rates shall be the maximum rates chargeable by the Franchisee.

**Section 2.** The new Rate Schedule set forth in Exhibit B shall be effective January 1, 2019 and Resolution No. 18-41 shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Commission.

Re: Oregon City Garbage Rate Adjustment

Dear Mayor Holladay,

We are honored to have provided solid waste services to the City of Oregon City for many years and look forward to providing services in the years ahead. Our service goal has been and will continue to be, to provide the highest level and efficient collection service available in the industry. We have automated lift collection vehicles and provide trash, recycling and yard debris residential collection; trash and recycling commercial collection; and drop box service. Being headquartered here in Oregon City and with many of our employees living in the city we take pride in working with the city to see the parks, cemeteries, vacant lots, etc. looking presentable.

Clackamas County reviews the financial results of each franchisee in the County. They contract with an outside consulting group specializing in solid waste financial analysis to perform an analysis of the data submitted. Expenses are adjusted to eliminate costs that are allowed for tax purposes, but not allowed for determining collection fees. The County's policy is to measure the health of the solid waste collection system within a range of 8-12% return on revenues. For 2017 the county collection system was within the range although in September of 2017 China stopped buying recycled material from the United States (Attachment A). This caused a complete change in the world market pricing. As such County staff requested a substantial unprecedented increase (\$2.80 on a 35gal cart). This is a quote from the staff report.

"The immediate effect on the County's collection system has been an increase in processing costs beginning in September 2017, reaching 375-400% above the cost reflected in our current fees. Costs are expected to remain at this level for the time being. Typically cost increases are gradual enough to absorb them in each review of the prior 12 months of the costs. These recent costs are unanticipated and rose quickly. Although our collection companies have limited ability to 'shop' for the best processing price, MRFs have increased costs across the board or restricted access, to varying degrees. Thus, collectors face a large gap between their costs and existing revenue from fees." At this time we are requesting a rate adjustment. The recycling change represents 57% of the rate adjustment. Since our last rate adjustment, solid waste disposal has increased by \$8.85/ton with \$3.19 in the current year and overall the solid waste change is 30% of the rate adjustment. Inflation coverage represents the remaining 13% of the adjustment.

We are providing a comparison of the rates in the surrounding County cities and unincorporated County inside the Urban Growth Boundary.

Thank you for your consideration of this rate adjustment.

#### **Rental Charge**

Occasional: \$7.00 per day after 2 working days at one site or \$70.00 per month whichever is less and only if less than one load per week is hauled.

Industrial/Commercial/Multifamily: \$55.00 per month each box

- Lid Charge \$5.00 per week billed on 1<sup>st</sup> day of delivery for boxes with an attached lid.
- Delivery Charge \$30.00
- Incidental Service Charges: \$7.00 per 5 minute increment

Standby Time: Charged when waiting for the box to be cleared, cars to be moved, etc.

Leveling Load: If a driver has to spend time getting the load level to haul it safely.

**Wash Out:** \$30.00 Assessed when the customer requests the service. Also assessed when drop box is contaminated and requires cleaning before delivering to a new site.

**Compactor Turn-around:** \$20.00 for compactor requiring repositioning on truck to enable collection and tip.

**Dry Run:** \$30.00 assessed when the scheduled collection is prevented because the box is blocked or the customer is not ready.

#### **Disposal Site Rejected load returned to customer:** \$50.00

**Deadhead Round Trip:** \$30.00 to be used for specialized boxes that cannot be exchanged.

# **Miscellaneous Services**

**Reinstatement Fee:** \$10.00 When service is reinstated after it has been stopped for non-payment of if customer stops and starts more than twice in a calendar year.

Cart Redelivery: \$15.00 If cart picked up then service restarted within 12 months for non-payment.

Introduction:

We appreciate the confidence the City of Oregon City has placed in Oregon City Garbage Company, Inc. Throughout our history with the City, we have made every effort to provide the highest level of service possible. In addition, we appreciate the opportunity to participate in the various community programs as we believe our relationship goes beyond that of a normal service provider.

#### Rationale for Rate Increase:

We have already automated the City for solid waste, yard debris, and recycling collections, and have gained substantial efficiencies by acquiring and implementing varying sizes of roll carts. These roll carts have made it easier for the citizens of Oregon City to recycle more and thereby dispose less garbage. Automating our recycling goals has indeed furthered our efficiency as well as assisted in diverting recyclable materials from the solid waste stream. Unfortunately, much of the gains from these improvements have been consumed by adding a necessary glass collection route. Due to the fact that recyclable glass needs to be separate from other recyclable material, we had to add an entire additional route for the recycling of glass. This of course was a negative in terms of overall efficiency. In summary, despite the addition of the new glass collection service line, we have endeavored to reduce the need for rate adjustments by effective and efficient operations.

Clackamas County currently manages 22 garbage disposal franchises. These franchises are held by locally owned Subchapter C corporations and by publicly traded corporations. Some of the franchises consolidate their annual reports, resulting in fewer reports than franchisees. The County has a contract with an outside consulting group specializing in solid waste financial analysis to perform an analysis of the data submitted. The data submitted by the individual franchises is consolidated to create a composite 'franchisee.' Costs are adjusted to eliminate those allowed for tax purposes but not allowed for determining collection fees. This composite is used to analyze the financial health of the entire system.

The County determines the systems' health based on return of revenues. The County's policy is to measure the health of the solid waste collection system within a range of 8-12% return on revenues. When the system falls within this range typically neither an increase nor decrease in fees is deemed necessary. Special circumstances, such as the addition of new programs or anticipated increases in expenses outside the control of the companies, may cause exceptions.

Metro Council has approved an increase in the disposal fee by \$3.68 per ton effective August 1, 2011; raising the tip fee to \$89.53 per ton. The 'transaction fee' of \$3.00 for account customers using the automated scale is to remain the same. For analytical purposes when calculating disposal cost it is assumed by Clackamas County that each transaction is a five (5) ton load; therefore an additional \$0.60 (to account for the transaction fee at the transfer station) is added to the disposal fee to arrive at an effective disposal fee of \$90.13 beginning August 1, 2011. This 4.29% increase has been factored into the projections calculated in the financial review. It is necessary to pass the disposal and transaction fees through to the customer to ensure franchises can recover the increase in costs. Disposal expense is approximately 30% of the direct operational expenses. It is important to note that other expenses are rising as well, including driver wages, fuel, and health insurance costs.

The recent global recession has had a significant impact on recycling markets. In setting rates for our waste collection franchise, proceeds from the sale of recyclables are used to offset the costs associated with the recycling program. Recyclables are commodities that are often exported to other countries around the world. As we export more recyclables each year, primarily to China, the revenues have been steadily decreasing. The cost of disposal is \$14.27 per ton while the cost to recycle is \$26.98 per ton; this means that it costs slightly less than twice as much to recycle solid waste than it does to dispose of it.

In determining the necessary rate adjustment we have researched other jurisdictions with primary reliance upon the Clackamas County Solid Waste Rate Study which recommended that rates be adjusted effective August 1, 2011. In light of this study and the increasing costs as described above, we are proposing a rate change for Oregon City effective February1, 2012.

#### Summary of Allowable Expenses:

The Clackamas County Solid Waste Rate Study uses financial information supplied by the various jurisdictions. The allowed return on revenues range between 8% and 12%. In calculating rates, the data that the haulers provide to the County include both allowable and unallowable expenses. Allowable expenses include but are not limited to:

- Disposal costs
- Cost of containers & roll carts
- Equipment acquisitions
- Wages
- Union benefits
- Fuel costs
- Legal & accounting services
- Office leases
- Other expenses directly related to the cost of service

The County eliminates unallowable costs in calculating a return on revenues for the haulers. Examples of unallowable costs include:

- Charitable contributions
- Political contributions
- Excessive officers' salaries as determined by the County
- Certain membership dues
- Excessive legal expenses
- And other costs not directly related to the hauling activities
