RESOLUTION NO. 19-23

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING OREGON CITY'S ELIGIBILITY TO RECEIVE STATE SHARED REVENUES

WHEREAS, ORS 221.760(1) provides as follows:

SECTION 1. The officer responsible for disbursing funds to cities under ORS 323.455, 366.785 to 366.820 and 471.805 shall, in the case of a city located within a county having more than 100,000 inhabitants according to the most recent federal decennial census, disburse such funds only if the city provides four or more of the following services:

- 1. Police Protection
- 2. Fire Protection
- 3. Street construction, maintenance and lighting
- 4. Sanitary sewer
- 5. Storm sewers
- 6. Planning, zoning, and subdivision control
- 7. One or more utility services

; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to establish compliance with ORS 221.760(1) by certifying the provision of municipal services.

NOW, THEREFORE, OREGON CITY RESOLVES that the City of Oregon City, Oregon, hereby certifies that it provides the following four or more municipal services enumerated in ORS 221.760(1) in the 2019-2021 Biennium and is eligible to receive state shared revenues in each of the two fiscal years:

- 1. Police protection
- 2. Street construction, maintenance, and lighting
- 3. Sanitary sewer
- 4. Storm sewers
- 5. Planning, zoning, and subdivision control
- 6. One or more utility services

This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Commission.
