- **Old Business** – Joan Schultze proposed a motion to approve the Minutes of the Meeting held on January 10, 2019. Seconded by Jan Keyser and approved unanimously.

- **Hilltop Fire Station 16.** Lieutenant Spencer Lambing reported Station 16 is up and running. Battalion Chief and 12 hour (8:00 am to 8:00 pm) medic unit and ladder truck now at Station 16. Station 16 is staffed by seven career personnel that work three separate 24 on 48 hours off shifts. Each shift has a company officer (a

lieutenant or captain), an apparatus operator, and two firefighters. Average of 6 to 10 calls per shift. Busy station – 169 calls in February – 3,029 in 2018. 15 new trainees at Academy to be spread across 20 fire station in district replacing retirees. Light on Molalla old and not necessary for vehicles to access Molalla.
