A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING A TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE GRANT TO UPDATE THE OREGON CITY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

- **WHEREAS**, the Oregon City Comprehensive Plan identifies our community values and vision for the future; and
- **WHEREAS**, the City Commission adopted goals and priorities for the 2019-2021 biennium including identifying grant opportunities and beginning the process to update the Oregon City Comprehensive Plan; and
- **WHEREAS,** since the Comprehensive Plan was last updated in 2004, not only has the population and geographic size of the City grown, but technology has influenced many facets of our lives from availability of information, to transportation, and social engagement; and
- WHEREAS, it is time to work together to create a community vision for the next 20 years and implement it though our Comprehensive Plan which represents all of our community and equitably supports it's members and implements state and regional requirements; and
- **WHEREAS**, the success of the project is dependent on a diverse, equitable, and inclusive process that includes new and innovative ways to obtain guidance from the public; and
- WHEREAS, we are pleased to support the City's approach focused on understanding and integrating all of the community members' visions for the future of the City into a Comprehensive Plan that focuses on equity and livability; and
- WHEREAS, the City was awarded a Transportation and Growth Management Program (TGM) grant from the Oregon Department of Transportation to fund a portion of the project including the transportation and land use components of the Comprehensive Plan; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Technical Assistance grant from the Department of Land Conservation and Development (DLCD) would fund a majority of the remaining portion of the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, OREGON CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** The City Commission of Oregon City supports engaging in the process of updating the Oregon City Comprehensive Plan as well as submittal of a Technical Assistance Grant as necessary to further that effort.
- **Section 2.** This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Commission.
