



COUNCIL RESOLUTION No. 69-2019

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, INITIATING A BOARD AND COMMITTEE YOUTH MEMBER PILOT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, engaging young Milwaukians has been identified as a critical goal of the city's community engagement work; and

WHEREAS, youth member participation on certain city boards and committees is a unique way to enhance public participation in the work of Milwaukie government; and

WHEREAS, the city and Milwaukie High School, Portland Waldorf School, La Salle Catholic College Preparatory, and Rex Putnam High School have expressed interest in initiating a pilot program to place students on city boards and committees.

Now, Therefore, be it Resolved by the City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, that the following actions are hereby authorized:

Section 1: City staff is directed to work with local schools to recruit individuals between the ages of 15 to 18 who live in the North Clackamas region to serve on the Arts Committee, Citizens Utility Advisory Board (CUAB), Design and Landmark Committee (DLC), Library Board, Park and Recreation Board (PARB), Public Safety Advisory Committee (PSAC), and Tree Board.


Section 2: City staff is directed to organize interview panels, following standard board and committee recruitment practices, to select youth nominees for the noted committees, and forward nominations to Council for consideration.

Section 3: Appointed youth members will serve for a one-year term and will be eligible for reappointment to a second year. All appointed youth members will enjoy all rights and responsibilities of full committee members, including the ability to vote on committee business, and will be held to the standards outlined in the city's Code of Conduct for Boards, Commissions, and Committees.




