

COUNCIL RESOLUTION No. 1-2020

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, RECOGNIZING THE ARTISTS AND DESIGNERS AND DONORS WHO WORKED ON AND SUPPORTED THE NEW LEDDING LIBRARY BUILDING.

WHEREAS, this city believes that libraries are a critical resource for all, regardless of race, ethnicity, creed, ability, orientation, gender identity or socio-economic status; and

WHEREAS, in May 2016 Milwaukie voters passed a bond measure to rebuild the Ledding Library to better serve our community and the North Clackamas area; and


