

**COUNCIL RESOLUTION No. 31-2020**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, ACTING AS THE LOCAL CONTRACT REVIEW BOARD, AUTHORIZING THE EXTENSION OF THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE TRI-COUNTY METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION DISTRICT OF OREGON (TRIMET), THE CITY OF PORTLAND, AND THE MILWAUKIE POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR TRANSIT POLICE SERVICES.**

**WHEREAS**, the city has a current intergovernmental agreement (IGA) with TriMet and the City of Portland for transit police services that is set to expire on June 30, 2020;

**WHEREAS**, the Milwaukie Police Department currently has two sworn staff assigned to the TriMet Transit Police Division whose salaries are reimbursed to the city at 105%;

**WHEREAS**, the COVID-19 pandemic has placed challenges on the standard procurement process to execute a new IGA with all participating agencies in the Portland metropolitan area; and

**WHEREAS**, an amendment to extend the term of the existing IGA will allow the Milwaukie Police Department to continue to operate under the same terms and conditions for transit police services.

**Now, Therefore, be it Resolved** by the City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, that the city manager, or their designee, is hereby authorized to sign and amend the term of intergovernmental agreement between TriMet, the City of Portland, and the City of Milwaukie for transit police services to December 31, 2020.

Introduced and adopted by the City Council on **May 19, 2020**.




