ORDINANCE NUMBER 1185, RATIFYING SALE OF WATER BONDS

It was moved by Clore, seconded by Strauss, that Ordinance Number 1185 (AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 1182 AND RATIFYING THE SALE OF CITY OF MILWAUKIE WATER BONDS 1968) be read the first time. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Clore, seconded by ^{STRAUSS}~~Slominski~~, that Ordinance Number 1185 be read the second time at the regular meeting of the City Council to be held on the 25th day of November, 1968. Motion carried and so ordered, by a majority vote of the full membership of the City Council.

PURCHASE OF BACKHOE

It was moved by Strauss, seconded by Clore, that the Council accept the recommendation of the City Manager and the Public Works Director to accept the bid of International Harvester for a 3514D backhoe, base bid being \$9,480.00, trade-in \$4,000.00, net city cost \$5,480.00, and retain the trade-in. Motion carried and so ordered.


CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION APPOINTMENT


It was moved by Strauss, seconded by Clore, that the Council reappoint Kenneth J. Levstone to the Civil Service Commission of the City of Milwaukie






