TOWN HALL, MILWAUKIE, OREGON, SEPTEMBER 2-1919.

The two hundred tenth regular meeting of the Town Council was held on the above named date. Meeting called to order by Mayor Snyder. Present, Mayor Snyder, councilmen Grasle, Albee, Miller Counsell and Hart, Recorder Mathews and Marshal Riley. The minutes of the 209 regular meeting of the council held on the 6th day of August, 1919, were read and approved as read. A petition signed by N. B. Harvey and others requesting the Council to apply all road taxes collected from the property abutting on Harvey's Lane be applied toward the improvement of said Street was read and upon motion duly made and carried was referred to Street Committee. The petition requesting the Mayor and Council to appoint a Boxing Commission was read and upon motion duly made and carried, the Mayor was authorized to appoint a boxing commission if upon investigation the petition contained a sufficient number of names of residents and tax payers of Milwaukie, Oregon.

A communication from the P. R. L. & P. Co. informing the Council that they had removed the guy stub and anchor on 32nd Street as requested by the council was read and ordered placed on file. The resignation of Samuel Riley as Marshal and Water Supt. was read and upon motion duly made and carried, the resignation of Mr. Riley as Marshal and Water Supt. was accepted. Upon motion duly made and carried, Mr. Hart was appointed temporary Water Supt. until some one could be found to take the job. Mayor Snyder appointed A. L. Reed Marshal to fill the vacancy caused by the resignation of Mr. Riley. Upon motion duly made and carried, the appointment of A. L. Reed as Marshal was confirmed.

Mr Counsell was instructed to remove the dirt and gravel in front of the New School House. The bill of Clackamas County for paving Main Street was read and referred to the Finance Committee.
