SPECIAL MEETING OF JANUARY 12,1962

Commission

A special meeting of the Milwaukie Planning was held on the twelvth day of January, 1962, for the purpose of a hearing on two proposed some changes.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Cecil Nickles.

Present: Chairman Cecil Nickles; Commissioners Max Thompson, Henry Stewart, Earl Clay and Earl Burdick. Absent: Commissioners John O. Sheldahl, Arthur Martineau, Marvin Shrock and Leonard Mullan.

The Chairman opened the hearing on the proposed zone change for the Cahill property, Tax Lot 64, Geo. Wills D.L.C. as described in Resolution P.C.4-1961, and called for objections to the same. It was shown that proper notice of the hearing had been given. There was no person present who objected and no written objection had been received. The Chairman declared the hearing closed.

The Chairman opened the hearing on a zone change for the Corti Property, Tax Lots 148 and 181, Whitcomb D.L.C. as described in Resolution P.C.3-1961, and called for objection to the same. It was shown that proper notice of the hearing had been given. There was no person present who made objection and no written objection had been received. The Chairman declared the hearing closed.

It was moved by Stewart and seconded by Thompson that the Commission recommend to the City Council that the zone be changed from 3-R-1 to Commercial-Industrial Zone on the Cahill property as described in Resolution P.C.4-1961. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Burdick and seconded by Clay that the Commission recommend to the City Council that the zone be changed from 3-R-1 to Commercial Zone for the Corti property as described in Resolution P.C.3-1961. Motion carried and so ordered.

Mr. Andrew Piller, made inquiry as to if or not a multiple dwelling could be placed on his property at 40th and Jackson Streets. Mr. Piller was advised to bring before the Commission a plan of the building and a plot plan of the property.

On motion duly made and carried the meeting adjourned.
