TOWN HALL MILWAUKIE, OREGON, MARCH 31st. 1915.

A special meeting of the Town Council was held on the above named date. Meeting called to order by Mayor Pelton. Present, Mayor Pelton, Councilmen, Bond, Peery, Counsell, Grasse and Skulason, Recorder Mathews, Treasurer Streib and Marshal Riley. The Mayor stated that the meeting was called for the purpose of considering the initiative petition requesting the Council to call a special election. Upon motion duly made and carried, the Recorder was instructed to notify the P. R. L. & P. Co. to remove the arc light in front of Mrs. Walker's place to the intersection of Henneman and Washington Streets. The Street Committee recommended that the Town put in a dam at the mouth of Kellogg Lake on Front Street on the east side of said Street. Upon motion duly made and carried the recommendation of the Street Committee was adopted and the Marshal was instructed to put the dam in.

Upon motion of Councilman Skulason seconded by councilman Counsell and carried, the Mayor was requested to confer with the County Court personally in regard to improving the Harvey Road.

Upon motion duly made and carried, the Treasurer was instructed to transfer \$1750 from the Front Street Fund to the General fund.

Upon motion of councilman Counsell seconded by councilman Bond and carried, the initiative petitions were referred to the license and election Committee for inspection, the Committee to report upon the same at the next regular meeting of the Council.

Upon motion duly made and carried, the meeting adjourned.
