COUNCIL CHAMBERS, MAY 25, 1936

The four hundred twentieth regular meeting of the Council was held on the 25th day of May, 1936.

The meeting was called to order by President of the Council Shrock.

The applications of R. C. Bagby for endorsement on his applications to the Oregon Liquor Commission for Retail Beer and Package Store Class "A" licenses for Crystal Lake Park were taken up for consideration. It was moved by Dell and seconded by Walsh that the Council favorably endorse the applications. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Burdick and seconded by Dell that the Recorder prepare and post an Ordinance amending Ordinance Number 362 so as to provide for a parking limit of two hours, between 8 A.M. and 5 P.M. on the following streets: Main and Front Streets between Washington and Jackson Streets; Jefferson, Monroe and Jackson Streets between Main and Front Streets.

It was moved by Dell and seconded by Wills that Street Commissioner Bevington properly barricade the north end of North Twenty Fourth Street and the West end of Washington Street. Motion carried and so ordered.

The question of the regulation of pin ballmachines was taken up. It was moved by Burdick and seconded by Dell that President of the

Council Shrock appoint a committee to examine the pin ball machines now in Milwaukie and to determine whether the same should be licensed. Motion carried and so ordered.

Burdick and Dell were named on said committee.

It was moved by Dell and seconded by Wills that Street Commissioner Bevington be authorized to purchase gravel and to proceed with the repairing of streets where needed. Motion carried and so ordered.

The Recorder stated that J. W. Matz desired permission to use Lot 20, Quincy Addition as a meeting place for young boys. It was moved by Dell and seconded by Walsh that such permission be granted. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Dell and seconded by Walsh that City Engineer Jones be authorized to prepare specifications for a pump for the large well. Motion carried and so ordered.

Upon motion duly made and carried the meeting was adjourned.

COUNCIL CHAMBERS, JUNE 8, 1936

The four hundred twenty first regular meeting of the Council was held on the 8th day of June, 1936.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Sanders.

Present: Mayor Sanders, Councilmen - Burdick, Dell, Shrock, Walsh and Wills; Water Superintendent Bevington, Marshal Riley, Fire Chief Jewelllyn and Recorder Adams.

The minutes of the four hundred nineteenth and four hundred twentieth regular meetings of the Council held respectively on the 11th and 25th days of May, 1936 and of the special meeting of the Council held on the 13th day of May, 1936 were each read and were each approved as read.

The Treasurer's monthly report was read and ordered filed.

The Fire Chief's monthly report was read and ordered filed.

A communication from the League of Oregon Cities requesting that the balance of ten dollars owing on the City's dues to the League for 1936 was read. It was moved by Dell and seconded by Shrock that the League of Oregon Cities be paid the ten dollars owing on Milwaukie's dues for 1936. Motion carried and so ordered.

A communication from Edith Hazen requesting that pin ball machines be barred from the City was read and ordered filed.

C. E. Smith and F. C. Fischer requested that a loading zone be established in front of the premises known as 1019 Main Street. It was moved by Burdick and seconded by Walsh that a loading zone be established in front of the premises known as 1019 Main Street such loading zone to be twenty feet wide. Motion carried and so ordered.

Fire Chief Jewelllyn requested an allowance of \$30.00 to cover expenses of a trip to the State Fire Chief's Convention at Marshfield. It was moved by Burdick and seconded by Wills that the request be granted. Motion carried and so ordered.

Ordinance Number 366 entitled: "An Ordinance providing for the issuance and sale of Milwaukie Fire Equipment Bonds in the sum of Seven Thousand five hundred dollars (\$7,500.00) dated as of August 1, 1936 of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon" was taken up for consideration and read for the first time. The roll call being taken the following result was had: Ayes, Burdick, Dell, Shrock, Walsh and Wills. Nays: None. Ordinance Number 366 passed the first reading.

It was moved by Burdick and seconded by Wills that the rules be suspended and that Ordinance No. 366 be taken up for the second time and be read by title only. The roll call on the motion being taken the following result was had: Ayes: Burdick, Dell, Shrock, Walsh and Wills. Nays: None. Ordinance Number 366 was read for the second time by title only. The Roll call being taken on the passage of Ordinance No. 366 on the second reading the following result was had: Ayes: Burdick, Dell, Shrock, Walsh and Wills. Nays: None.
